



## Sindh-Pakistan Rain Emergency Appeal by HANDS

September 11-2011

Come and join hands with HANDS Pakistan to save lives of millions!

### Background:

Sindh province is once again enveloped by monsoon torrential rains which have lashed various districts of the province and displaced a large number of people. Sindh Province is experiencing



torrential rains worst ever in history of 100 years. Heavy rains and subsequent flooding has almost destroyed 22 district of Sindh Province out which 10 districts are badly affected and thousands villages are left under 10 ft water. The Flood impact is vastly accentuated due to widespread breaches in agricultural canals and saline water drains in Sindh.

The current rains spell is impacting across some of the 2010 Floods seriously affected

districts, which means that the residual vulnerabilities are being reflected in the emerging humanitarian situation. Floods have caused major population dislocations and people were helpless to leave their home with empty hands but story of their miseries is not ended here as torrential monsoon rain continued to batter the province and miserably people are unable to find safer place to protect themselves, their kids and their livestock as well. Tent cities are inundated and government school buildings are also under water. Due to continue rains, buildings are in danger conditions and not safer place to accommodate displaced people.

Devastating rains across Sindh province have not only caused loss of precious life and property, but heavy downpour has adversely affected Kharif crops of cotton and paddy and washed away vegetables and fodder on thousands of acres in lower region of the province.



### Losses and Damages:

Different organizations have conducted rapid assessments and analyze the losses and damages. According to Provincial Disaster Management Authority (PDMA) report on losses and damages released on 10 September 2011 @ 1900 hrs validated that;

- No of affected Districts: 22
- No of affected Talukas: 75
- No of affected Union Councils: 545
- No of affected villages: 28,684
- No of affected persons: 5.3 million
- Total area affected: 4.4 million acres
- Total crop area affected: 1.5 million acres
- No of partially damaged houses: 406,782
- No of fully damaged houses: 423, 432
- Casualties reported: 209

- Injuries reported: 488
- Cattle head perished: 8,350
- Relief Camps Established: 2,490
- No of persons in relief camps: 275,440

This is noteworthy that these figures are not accurate and final as data is awaited from various districts where district governments and local NGOs are engaged in gathering the information.



Situation is getting more worsen day by day as torrential rains are still devastating the areas and people are unable to find safe places. So far, this data might be more than doubles after having final reports and assessments.

Miseries of displaced people can't be translated into words. Still thousands peoples are marooned in deep waters and all access roads are collapsed. Evacuation and provision of life saving objects are very essential. If people are rescued and given life saving objects, casualties might increase rapidly. Life

is very precious asset that is losing from hands like sand.

### Response and Immediate Requirements:

HANDS, one of the largest Non for Profit Organization in the country conducted rapid assessment in badly affected 10 districts and started relief operations. HANDS mobilized team of 350 professionals in rains affected areas for relief and rescue operations. Following is the district wise details of relief operations carried out by HANDS in 10 districts.

While in relief operation, it came across that a large number of families who do not have access to aid resources and they are unable to get anything which protects them in harsh weather conditions. These families are still looking for shelter, food ration and health services.

**Therefore HANDS plans to reach at least 100,000 families (700,000 persons) in most vulnerable and affected districts of Sindh Province in two month time period. As per cost estimation, per family requires PKR 20,000.00 (231.21 US\$) to have ONE MONTH food ration, adequate WASH facilities, Shelter and Health Services. In regard to achieve target of 100,000 families, HANDS would be in need of PKR 1,756,250,000.00 (US \$ 20,303,468.21) to provide adequate relief assistance to rain affected people.**
